The CICLAMADRID Gran Tour is a major 420-kilometres itinerary to be followed by 17 stages covering between 15 y 38 kilometres each. Why not do it at least once in your life? Three of Unesco's World Heritage Site destinations, seven Towns of Madrid, enchanting villages, historic gardens and natural parks... All of Madrid in only 17 steps.

The Tour fits almost everyone and can be adapted to the characteristics of each one as long as you only have to join stages wherever you want, or do them all one by one. The stages are about 25 kilometres.

Mornings are for cycling, afternoons for wandering... That's the idea.

The Sierra Norte de Madrid is a natural paradise made up of mountains and valleys with abundant and varied vegetation and fauna. Within its term are the Peñalara Natural Park, the Montejo Beech Forest and the Sierra del Rincón Biosphere Reserve, landscapes that invite you to enjoy mountain biking with friends.

CICLAMADRID also offers a great route especially designed for MTB. The itinerary covers the perimeter of the Sierra Norte (Northern Range) over a distance of 213 km, with numerous approaches to towns where you can find all kinds of restaurants, accommodation or other tourist services.

Countryside cycle tourism / 62 km Average gradient per route: 870 m 3 days / 2 nights / 2 routes

The Sierra Oeste (Western Range) offers numerous tourist attractions, among them a vast forest mass of enormous environmental value, the Castle of La Coracera, the Enchanted Forest or wine tourism, with wines from the Vinos de Madrid Designation of Origin and many choices for activities organised by the wineries throughout the territory.

Here is also the San Juan reservoir, one of Madrid's beaches, with its Marina. The Enchanted Forest is a fascinating botanical forest that is home to 500 types of plants and 300 plant sculptures that represent forms as diverse as a dragon, an elephant or a locomotive

CICLAMADRID proposes two routes in this area, riding along extensive pine forests, rivers and meadowlands.


