UNESCO declares places of outstanding universal value to humanity as World Heritage Sites. They are breathtaking places, with a rich heritage due to their cultural or natural significance. Spain has the honour of ranking third among the countries with the most World Heritage Sites, only behind Italy and China.

In the Community of Madrid, we're proud to say that we've got five World Heritage Sites:

- Monastery and Royal Site of San Lorenzo de El Escorial
- University and Historic Precinct of Alcalá de Henares
- Aranjuez Cultural Landscape
- Landscape of Light in Madrid
- Montejo Beech Forest

All of them are less than 100 kilometres from Madrid city centre. You definitely can't miss out!

To make the most of your visit, here are some maps to help you plan out your trips between the top landmarks of the World Heritage Sites in the Community of Madrid.

Don't forget that UNESCO has also declared flamenco as Intangible Cultural Heritage and Madrid is the capital of flamenco!

Get around the Community using public transport to visit these amazing places: you can get to them by bike, train or bus while helping to promote sustainable mobility.

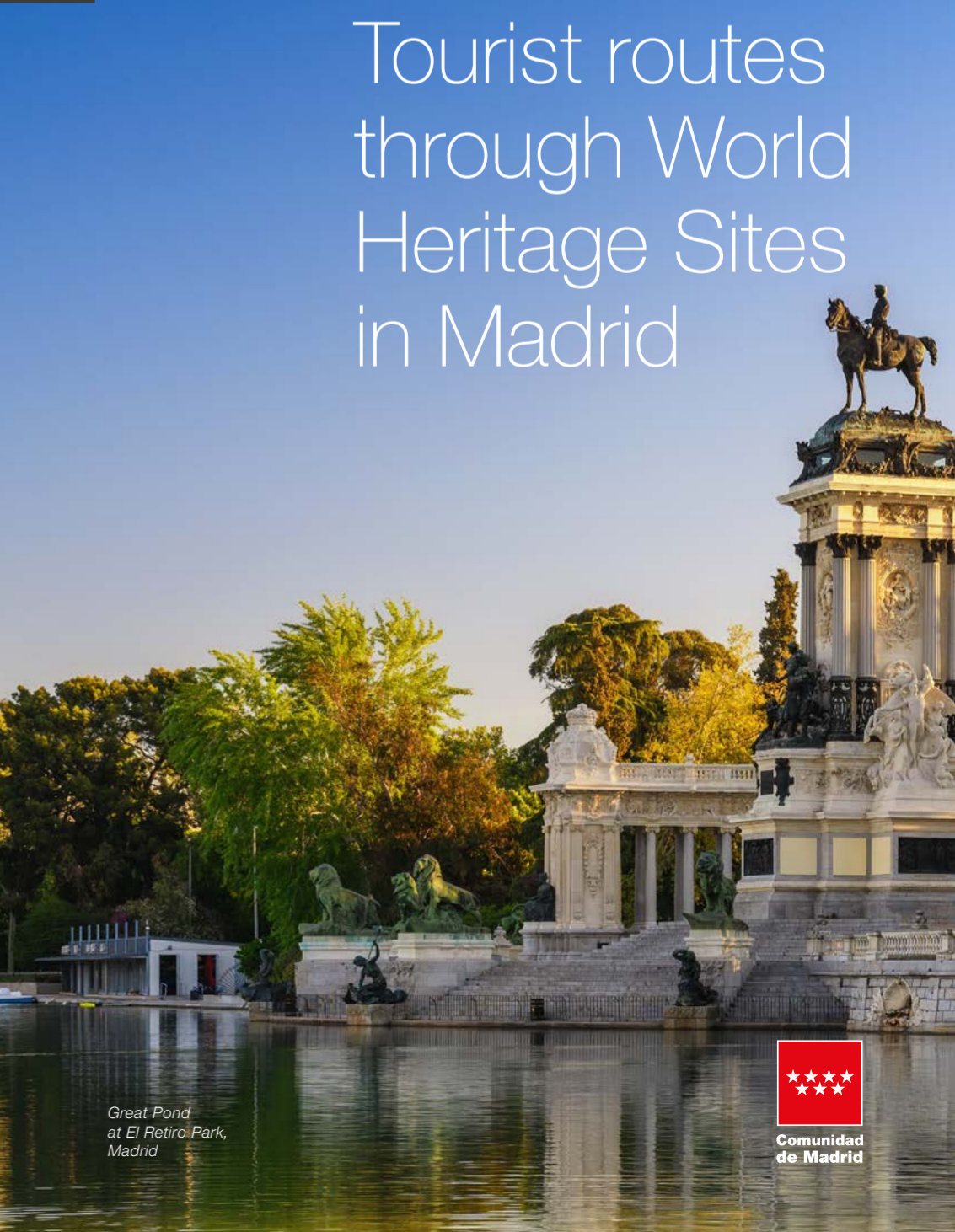
