What is gender violence?

It is produced as a manifestation of historically unequal social, economic and cultural relations and includes any physical or psychological aggression against a woman that is likely to adversely affect her health, her bodily integrity, her sexual freedom, or any other situation of distress or fear that restricts her freedom. Likewise, Gender Violence is considered to be violence against minors and dependents of a woman when they are assaulted with the intent to do harm to the woman.

Where can I go?

Women in these situations can access the **NETWORK OF MUNICIPAL POINTS OF GENDER VIOLENCE OF THE COMMUNITY OF MADRID,**

where a global and comprehensive social, psychological and legal intervention is available.

You will find a multidisciplinary team of professionals who will assist you and, if necessary, refer you to the different specialized services.
