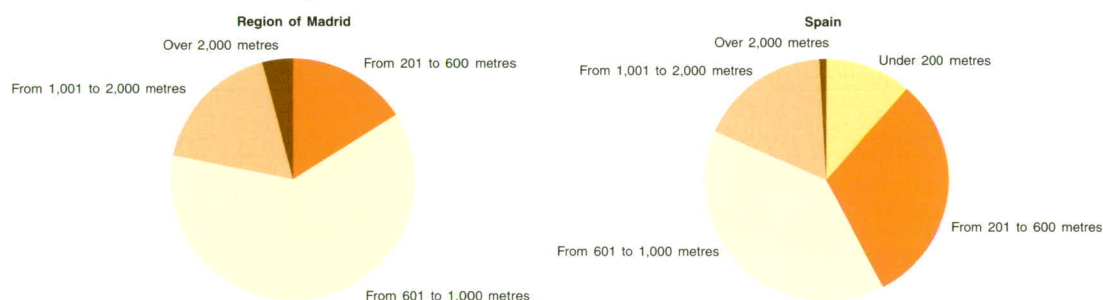

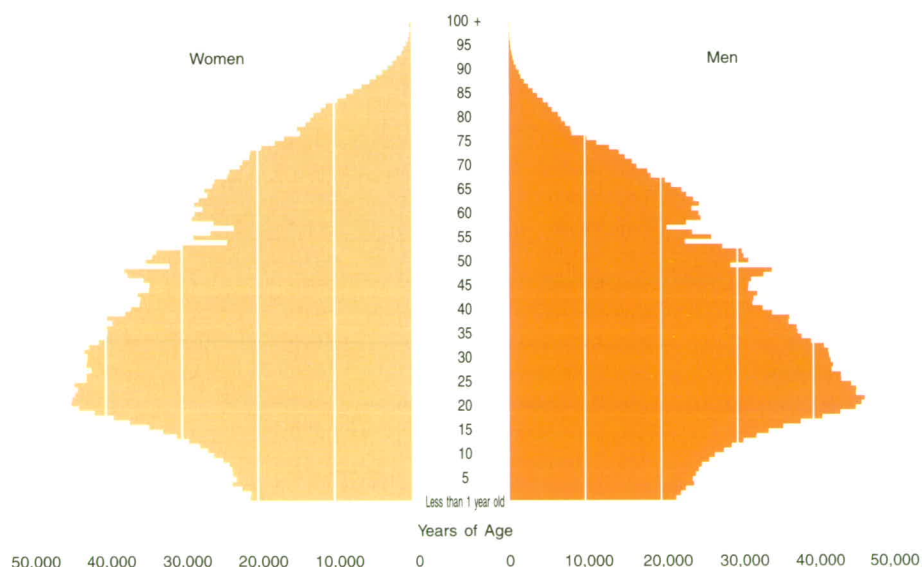

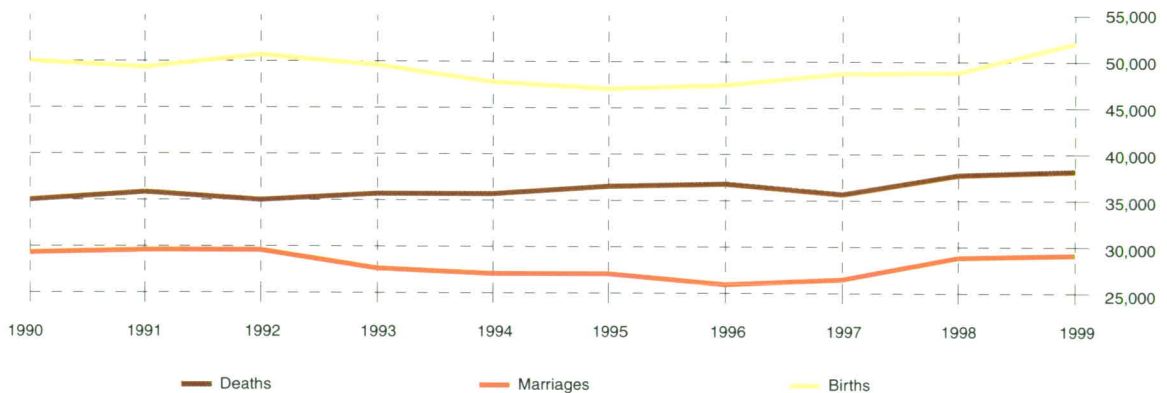

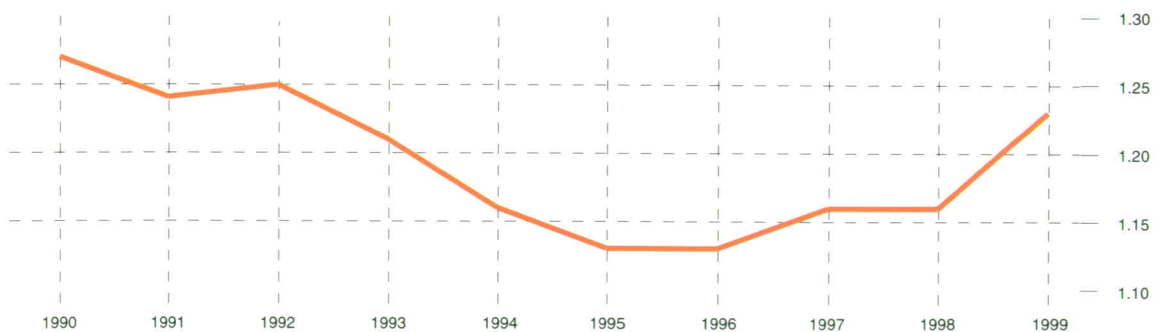

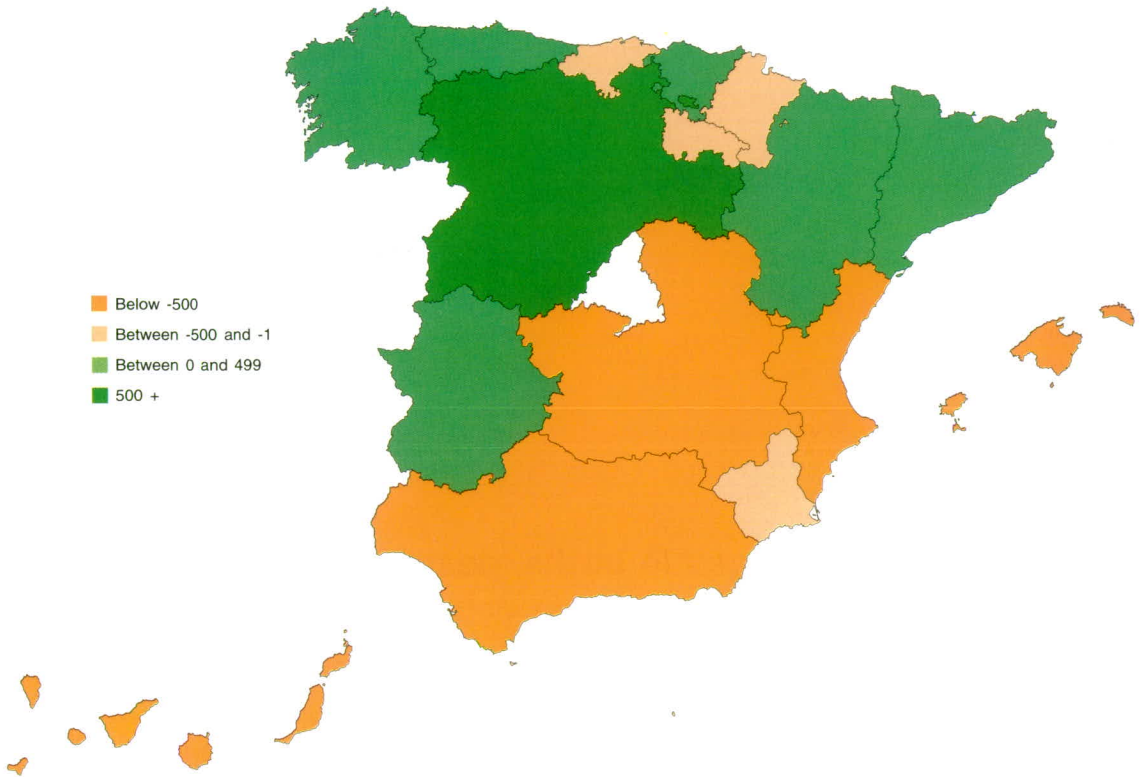
2.4. Year-on-year changes in births, deaths and marriages

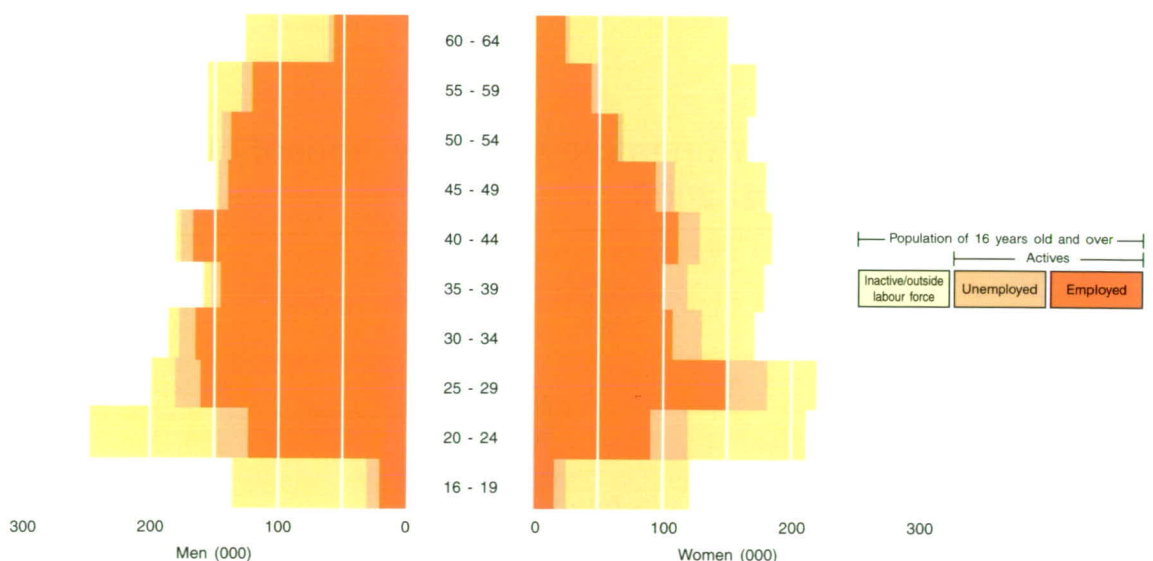

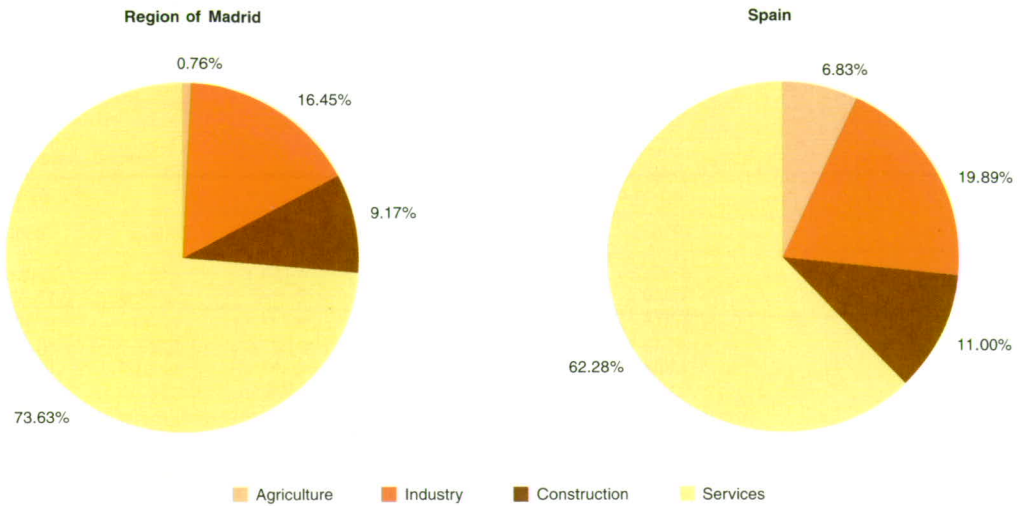

3.2. Breakdown of the employment status by age and sex. 2000

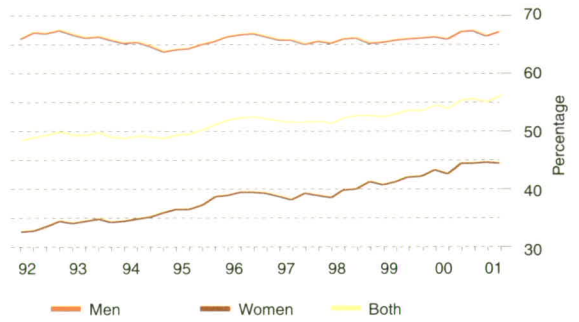
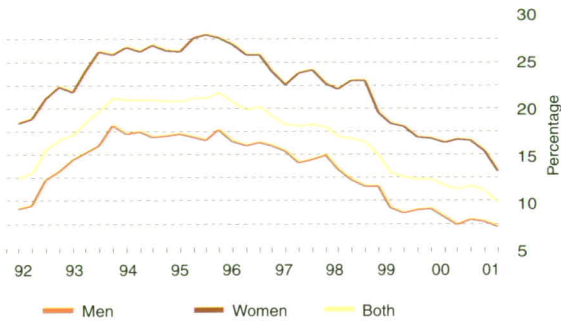


3.3. Breakdown of employment by sectors. 2000

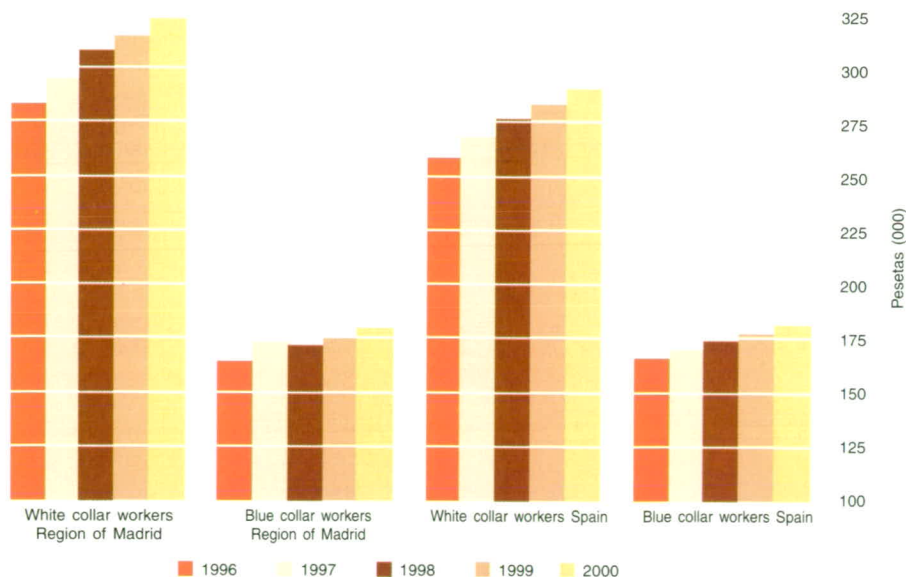

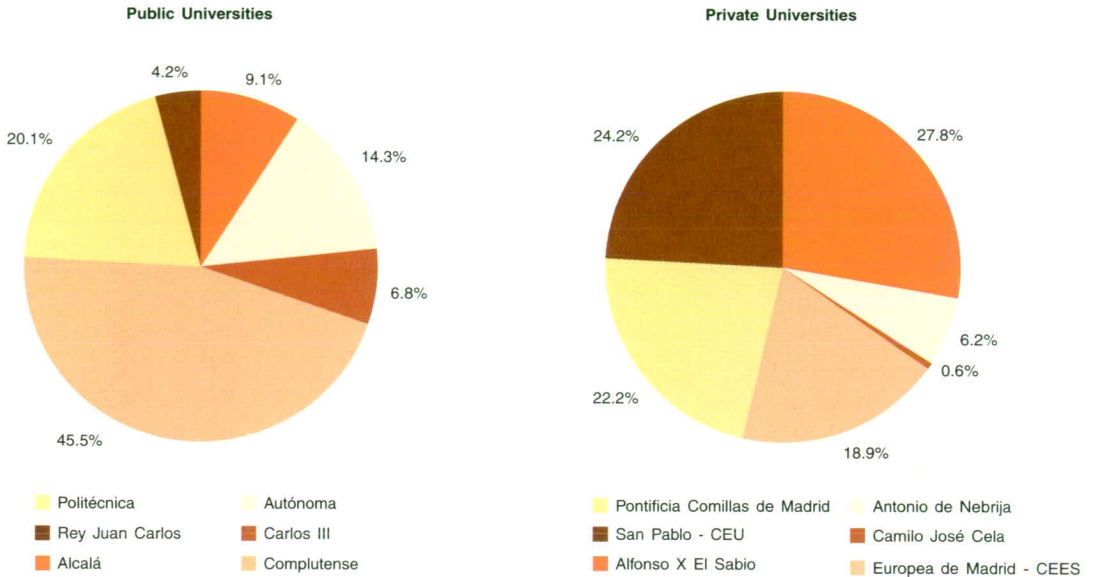

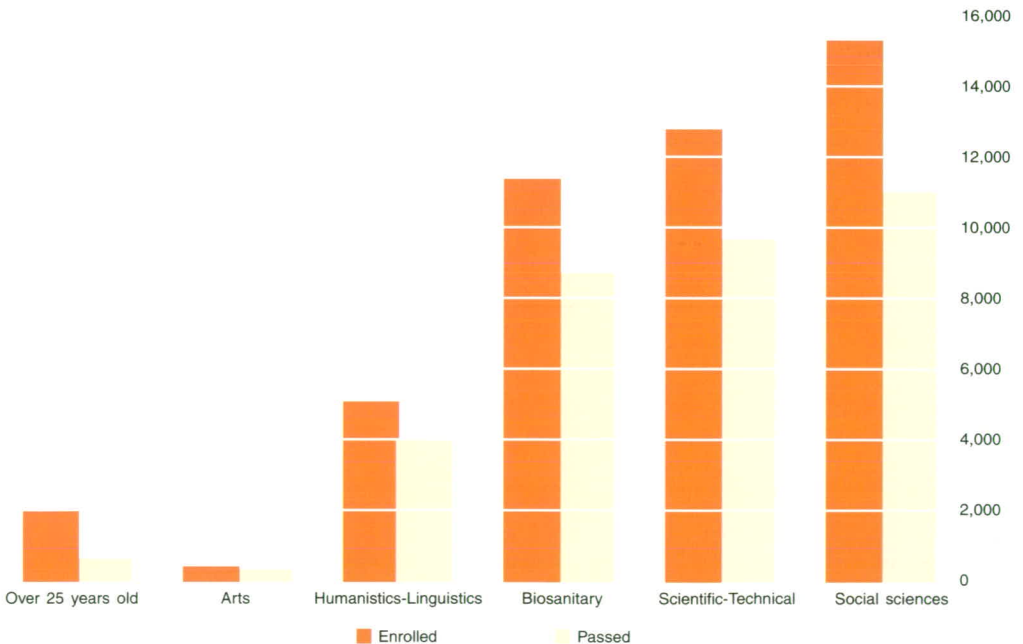

5.4. Breakdown of the students who had pass the University Entrance Exam. Enrolled and passed. 2000



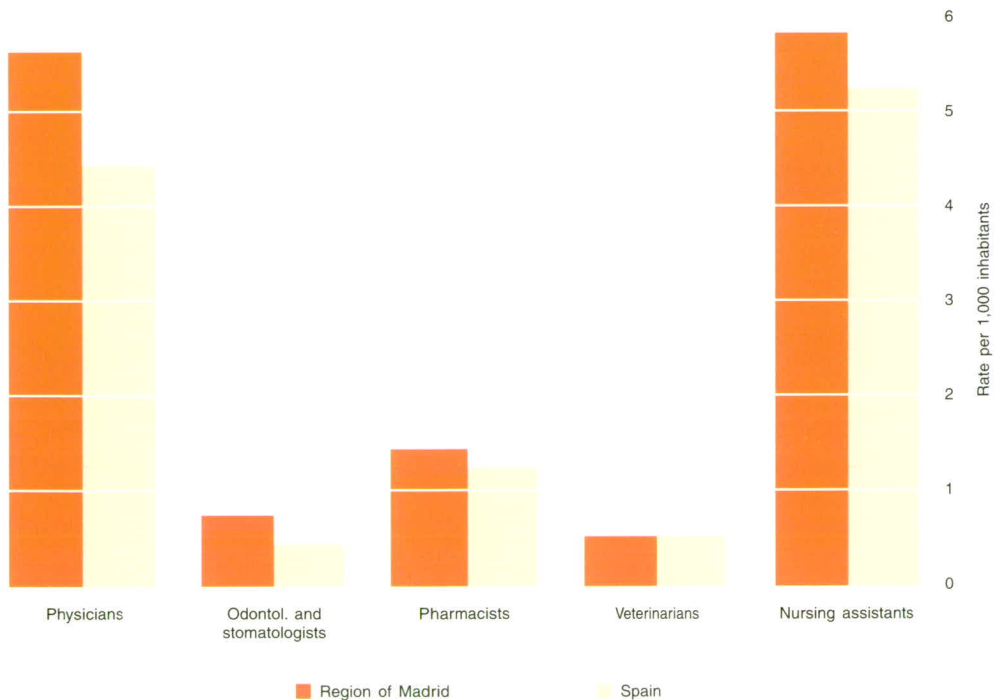

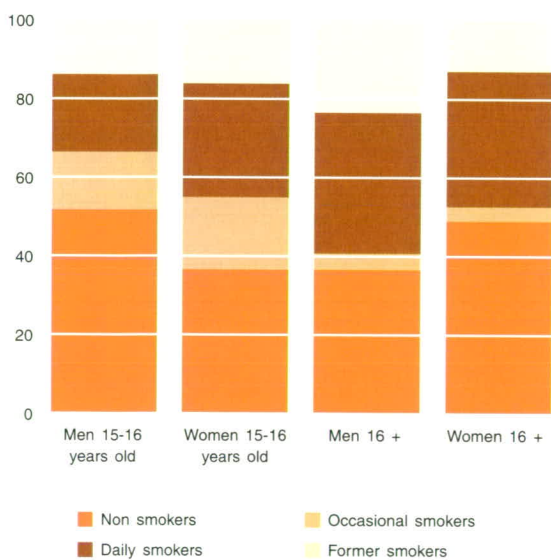

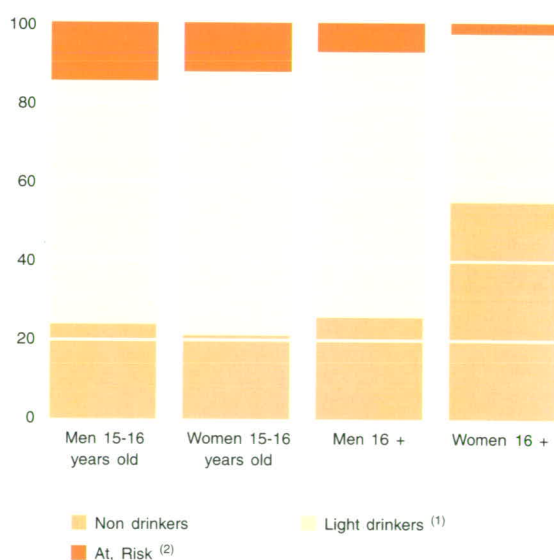

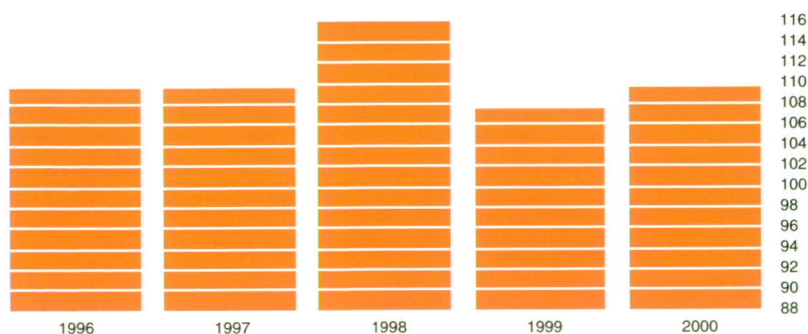

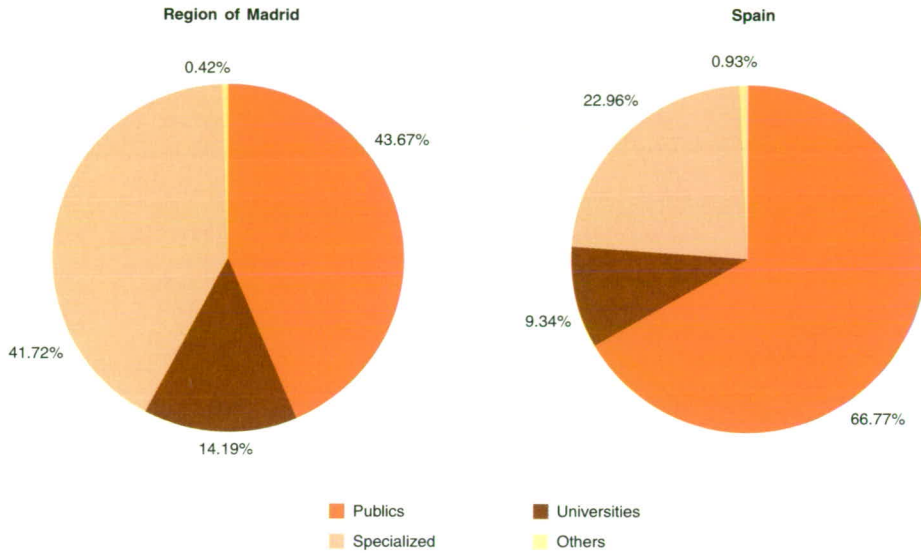

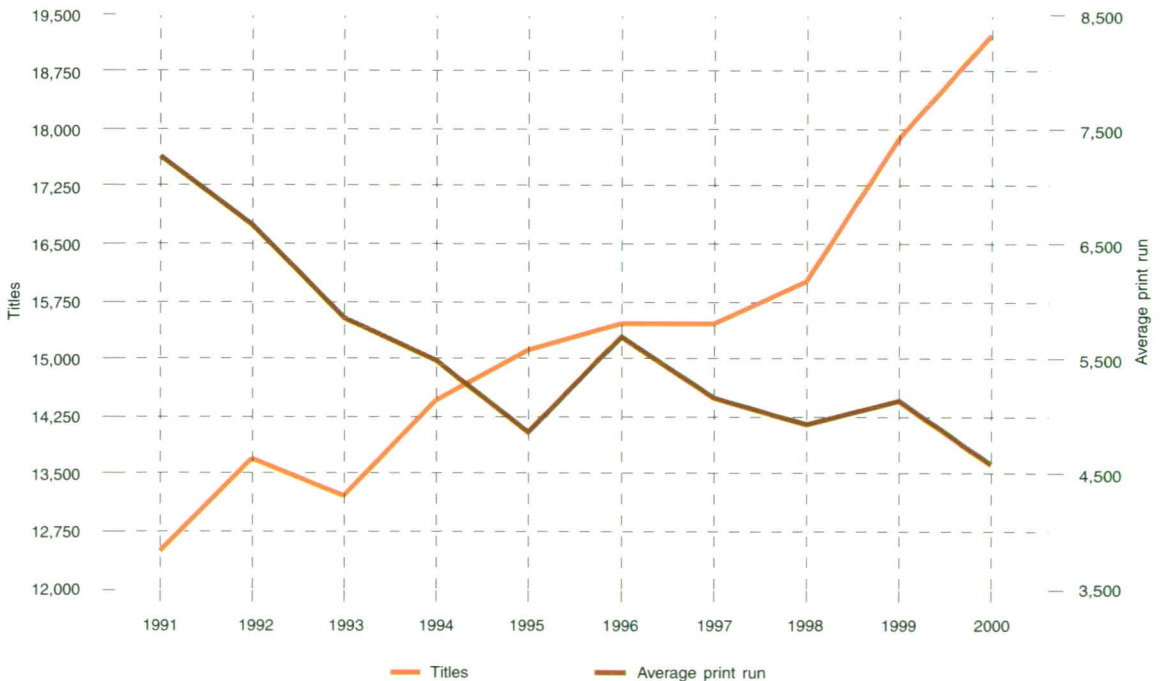

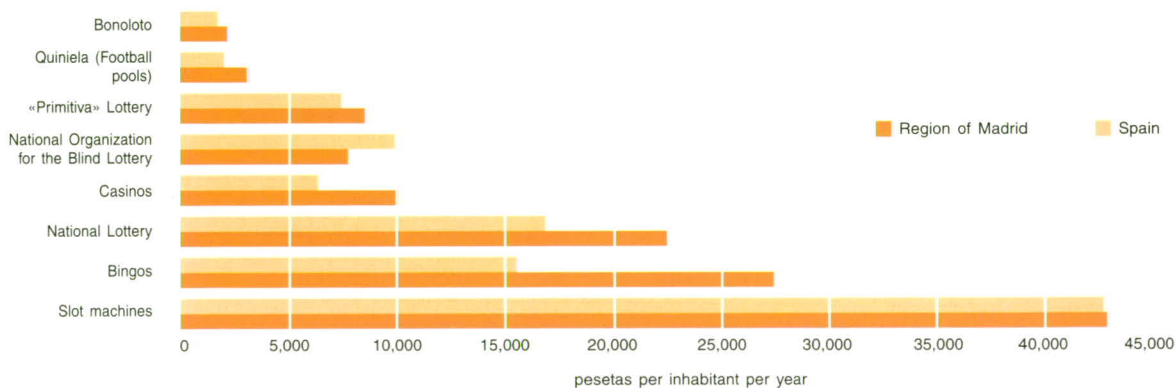

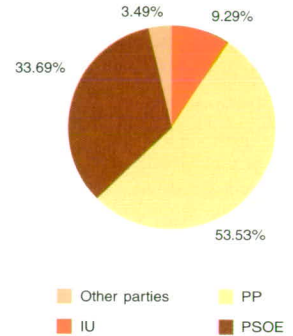

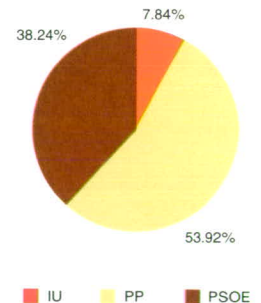
Breakdown of votes for Parties and Coalitions

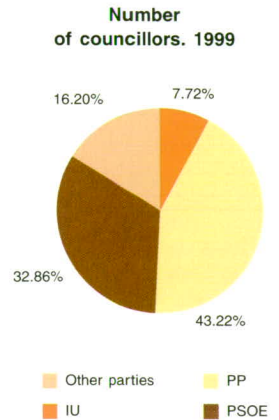

Breakdown of the seats. 1999



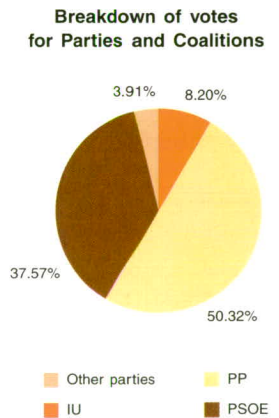

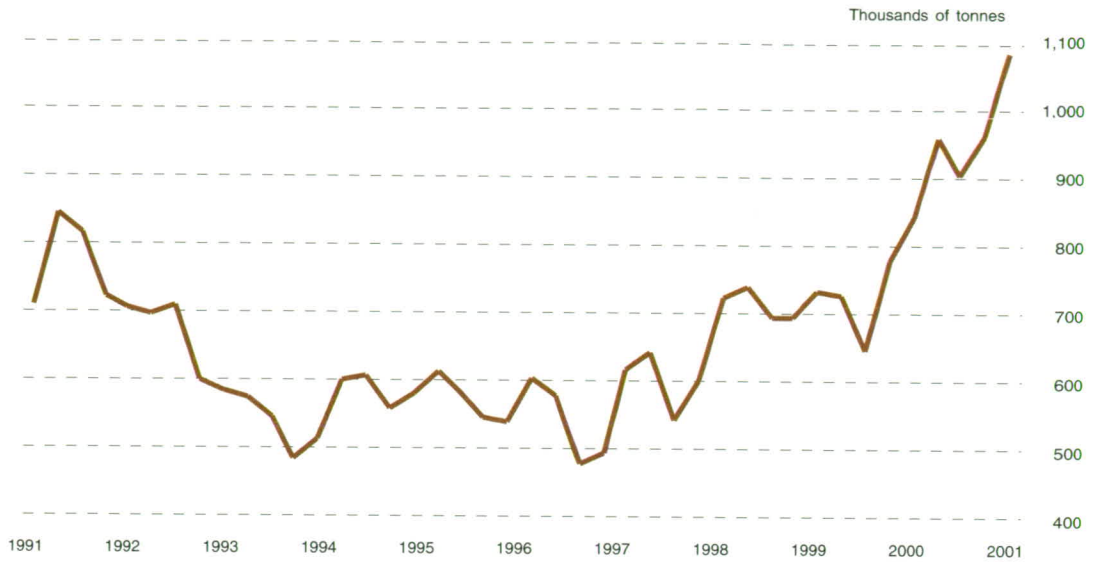

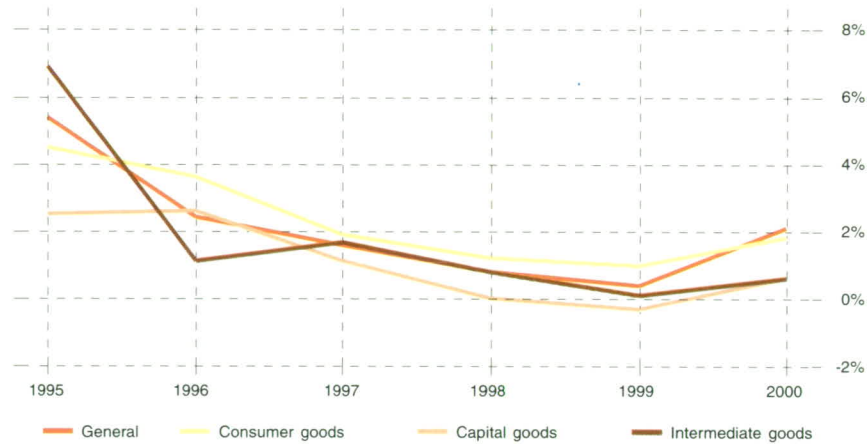

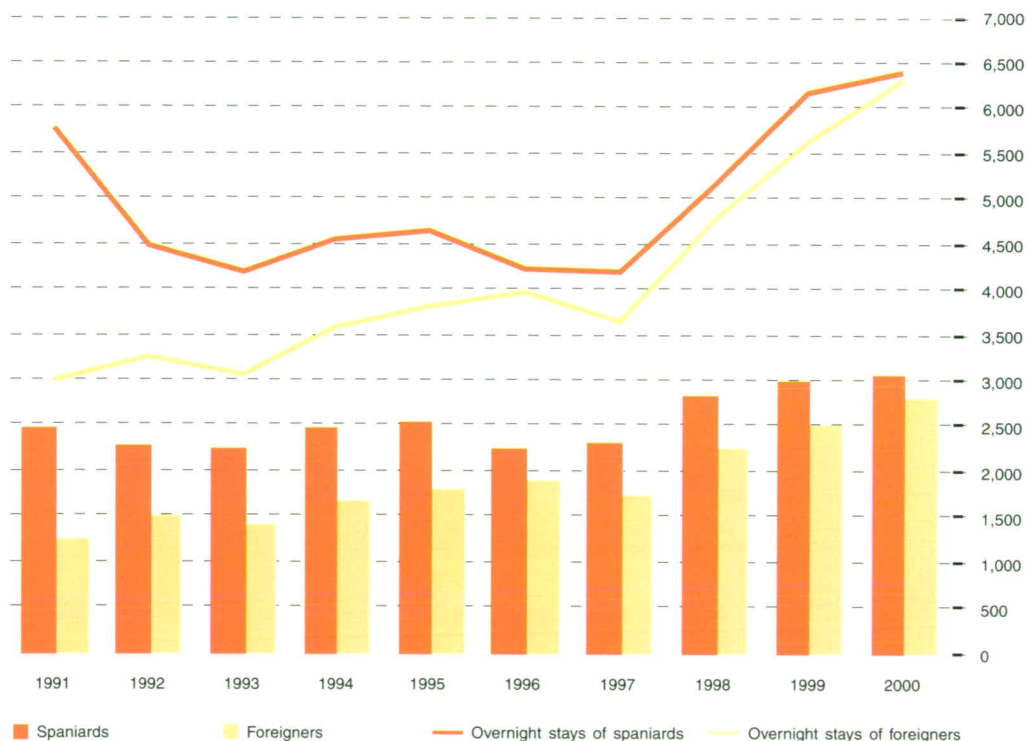

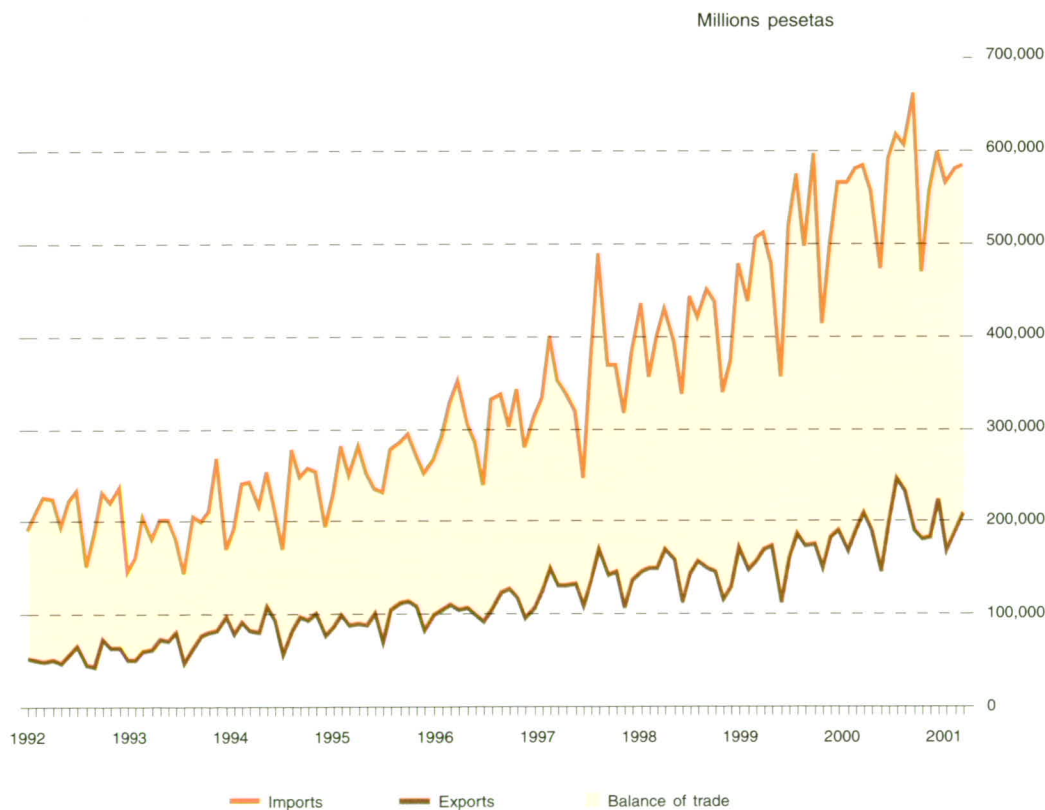

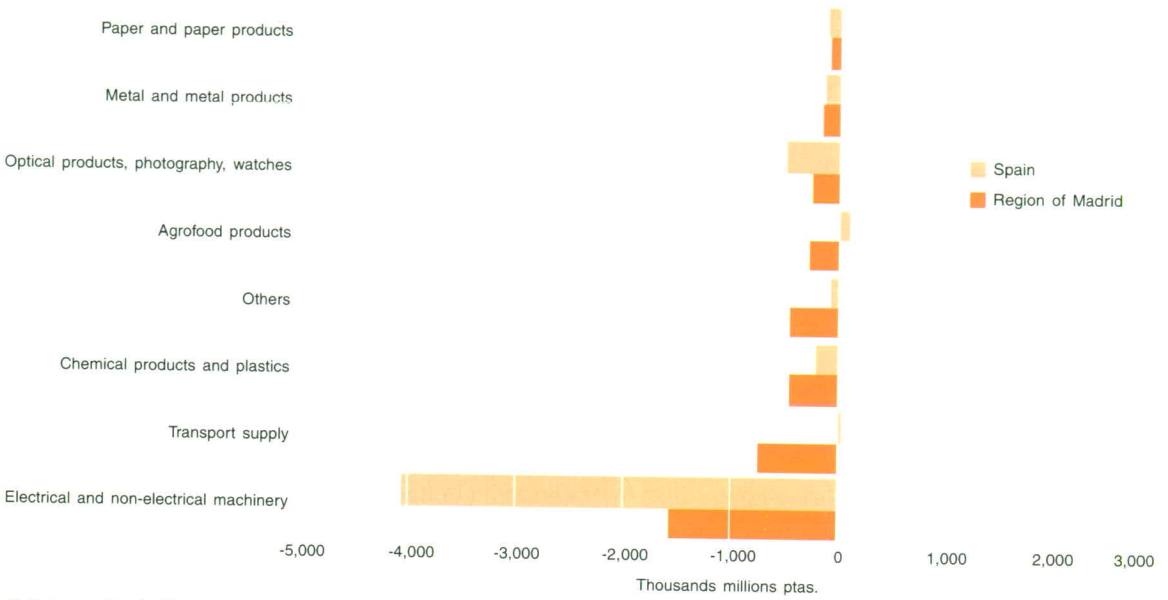

13.6. Year-on-year change in foreign trade

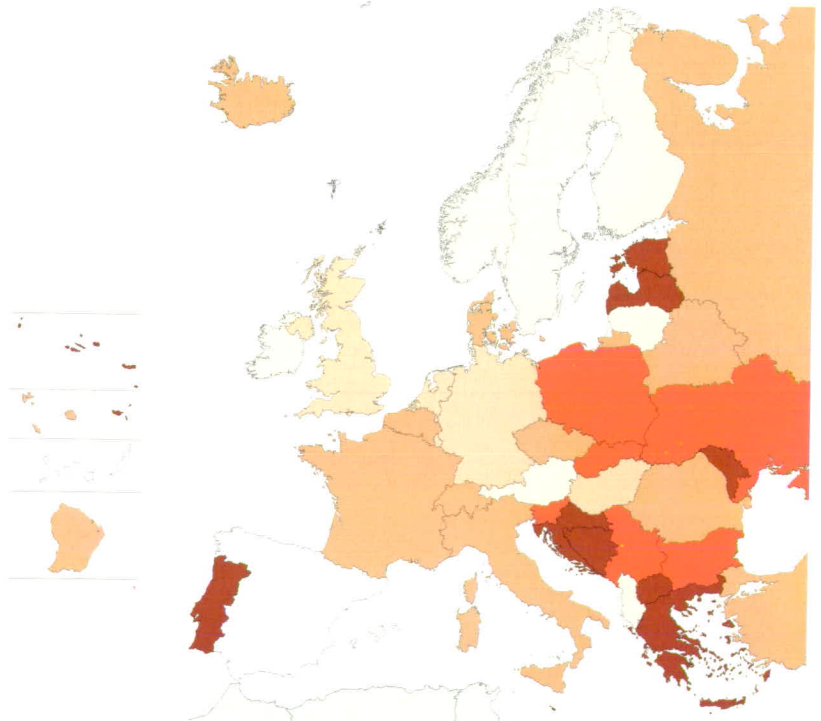


13.7. Balance of trade by products*. 1999

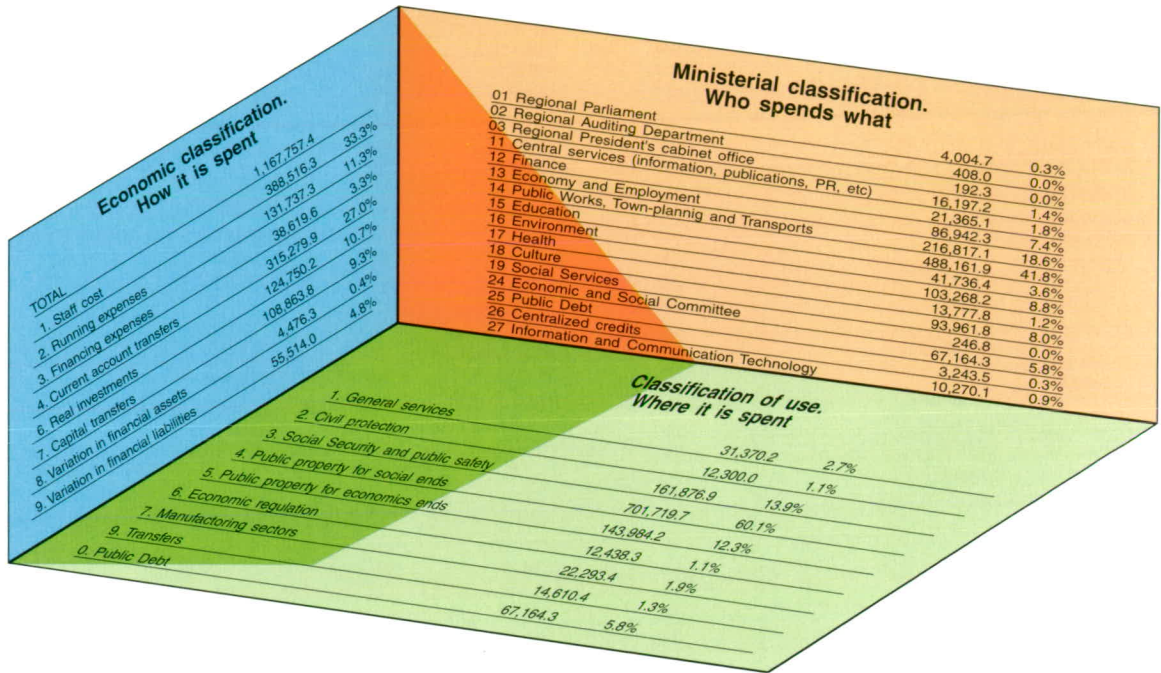

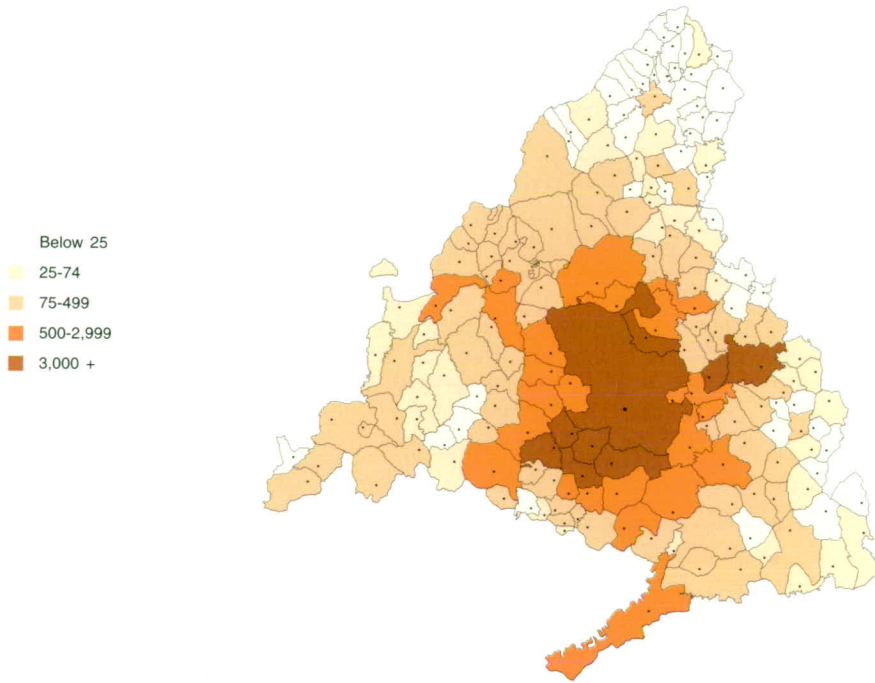
17.2. Population density. 2000



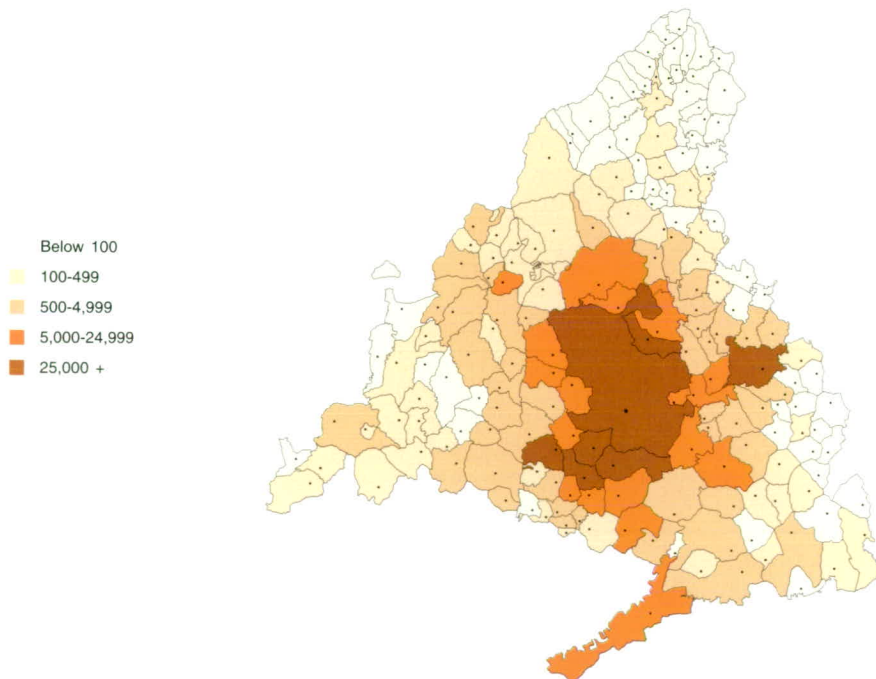
17.3. Per capita family disposable income. 1997 (provisional)



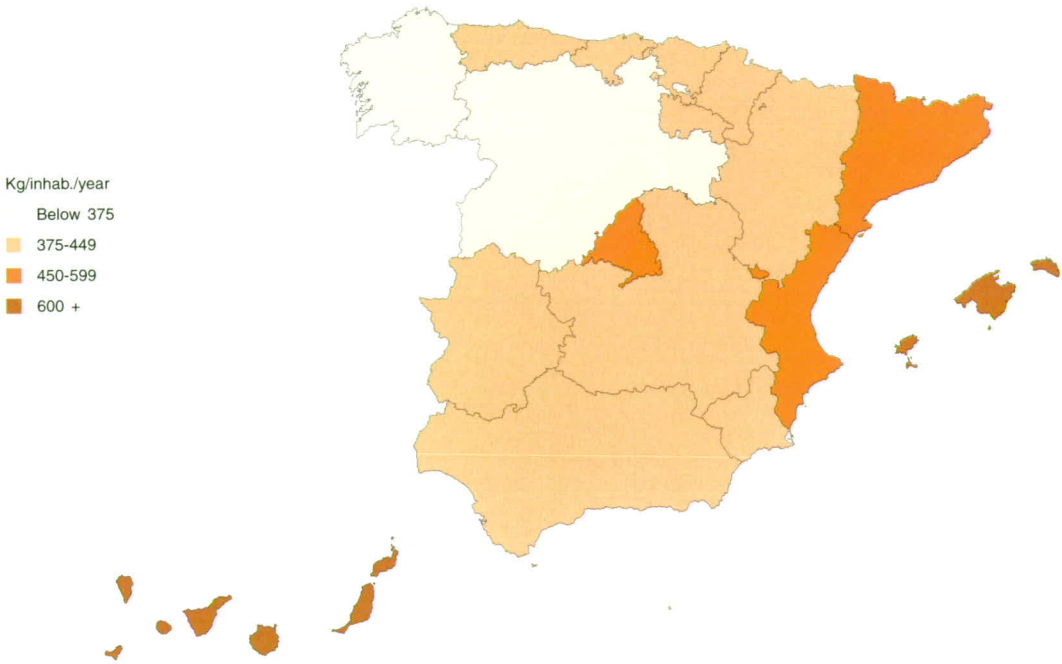
17.4. Economic activity units. 2000



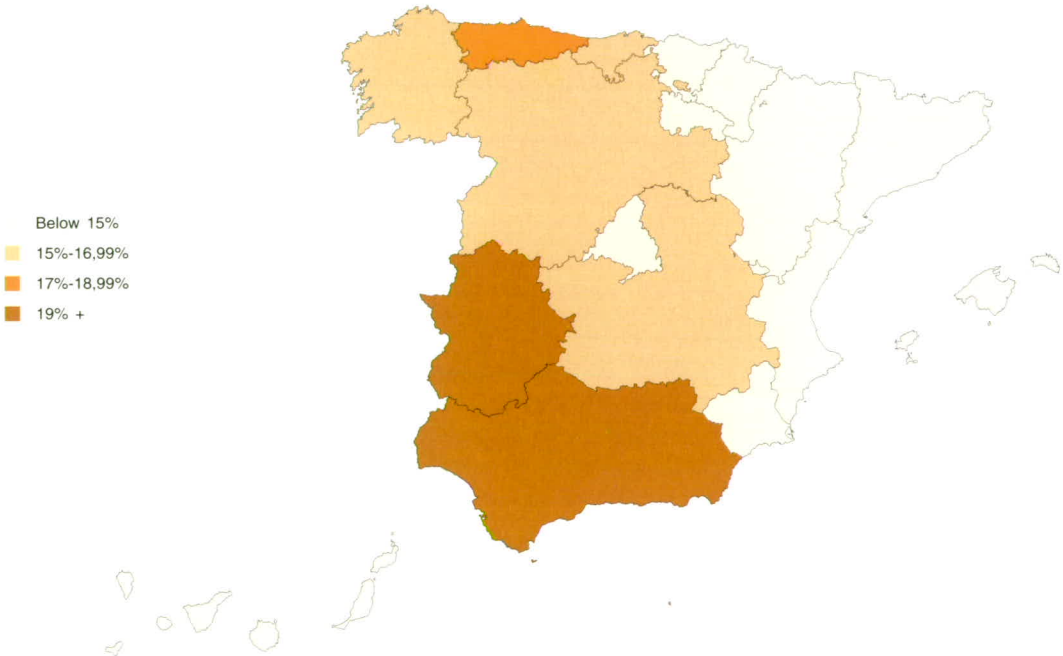
17.5. Employed in economic activity units. 2000

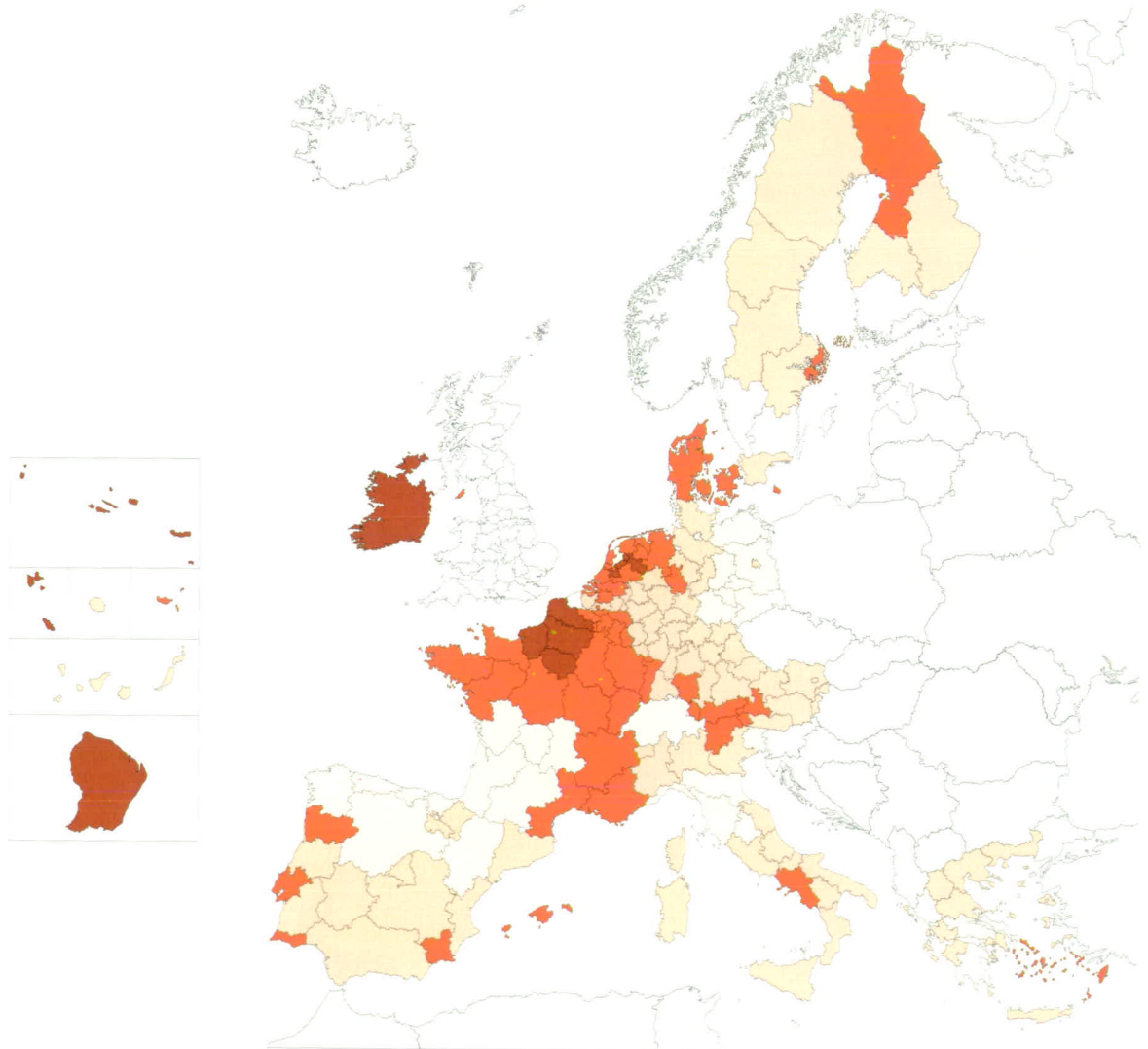


17.7. Unemployment rate. 2000



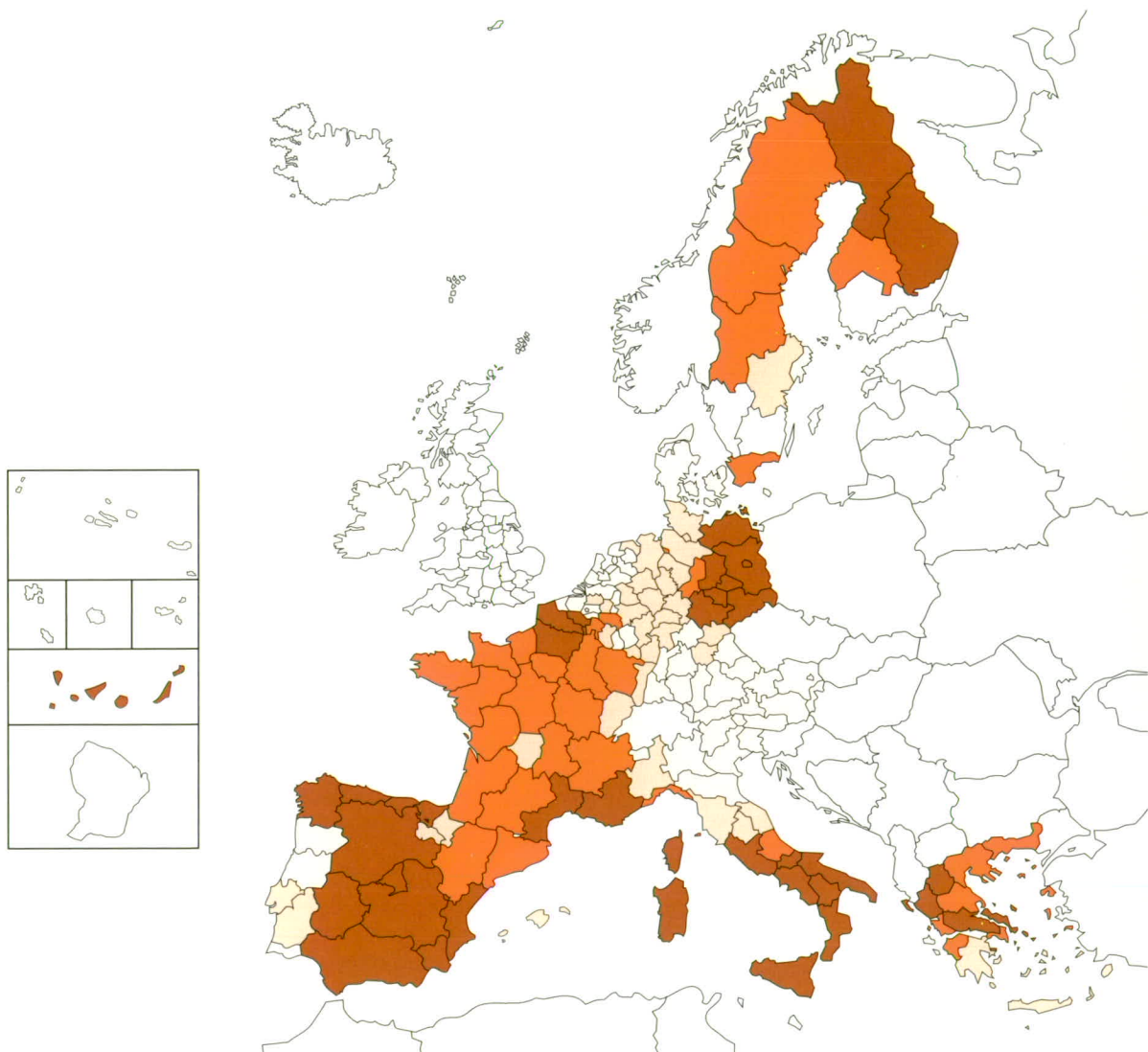
